Delhi Traffic Police Ensures Timely Passage for Heart Patient Amid Traffic Congestion.

New Delhi, 08 September 2026:

Under the close supervision of Dr. Sachin Kumar Singhal, IPS, DCP Traffic, Northern Range, Delhi Traffic Police once again demonstrated promptness, sensitivity and commitment towards public service by facilitating the safe and timely movement of a heart patient through heavy traffic congestion.

At about 07:57 PM on 07.09.2026, a congestion call was received in the traffic group regarding heavy traffic near Mukarba Chowk. The caller, Sh. Rajkumar, resident of Alipur Village, informed that he was taking his 49-years-old relative (female), a heart patient, to Santom Hospital, Pitampura, and urgently requested traffic assistance.

On receiving the information, Inspr. Kamal Kohli, TI Ashok Vihar, immediately mobilized traffic staff. ASI Anand Singh, No. 300/T, and HC Manish, No. 3256/T, of Ashok Vihar Circle were deployed along the route to facilitate the patient's movement.

The traffic staff promptly regulated the movement of vehicles, including temporarily regulating one carriageway, to ensure a smooth and uninterrupted passage for the vehicle carrying the patient.

Through timely coordination and dedicated efforts, the patient was safely escorted to Santom Hospital, Pitampura, without further delay.

The complainant and his family expressed their heartfelt gratitude to the Delhi Traffic Police for the prompt response, assistance and support during the critical situation.
