Subject: Special Enforcement Drive Against PUCV Violations Conducted Across Northern Range Traffic.

On the directions of Dr. Sachin Kumar Singhal, IPS, DCP Traffic, Northern Range, a special enforcement drive against vehicles plying without a valid **Pollution Under Control Certificate** (PUCV) was conducted across the Northern Range on 03.09.2026.

During the drive, Traffic Police personnel carried out intensive checking of vehicles at various locations and took strict action against violators. A total of **238 challans** were issued to motorists found violating the mandatory PUCV requirements.

The drive was aimed at ensuring compliance with pollution-control norms, promoting environmentally responsible driving and strengthening road discipline among motorists.

Northern Range Traffic Police appeals to all vehicle owners to keep their PUCV certificates valid and comply with all statutory requirements. Regular vehicle pollution checks are essential not only for avoiding legal action but also for contributing towards cleaner air and a healthier environment.
