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Delhi Traffic Police Conducts Joint Motorcade Rehearsal with Ministry of External Affairs for BRICS Summit Security Arrangements

On September 2, 2026, Delhi Traffic Police, along with the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) and other agencies involved in BRICS Summit arrangements, conducted the first joint motorcade rehearsal to fine-tune security and traffic arrangements for the upcoming BRICS Summit, scheduled to be held in Delhi from September 11th to 13th at Bharat Mandapam.

The motorcade rehearsal covered a total of 12 locations, comprising 10 hotels earmarked for visiting dignitaries & delegates and two other locations. Motorcades moved from these locations to Bharat Mandapam at 10.30 AM and made the return move from Bharat Mandapam at 03.30 PM. As part of the exercise, 22 diversion points were established across the city to manage traffic flow with minimal inconvenience to the general public. The rehearsal was conducted smoothly, with citizens' convenience given due priority throughout.

Following the rehearsal, a debriefing session was held at Bharat Mandapam, joined by Delhi Police, Delhi Traffic Police, the Security Wing of Delhi Police, the MEA, and other agencies involved, to further fine-tune and synchronize the motorcade movement and other arrangements.

Delhi Police reiterated its commitment to ensure smooth and secure arrangements for the BRICS Summit 2026, keeping citizens' convenience at the forefront.
