Subject: Recovery of Stolen Scooty.

On 25.08.26 a dedicated team from Model Town Traffic Circle, comprising ASI Mahavir Singh (No. 1756/T), HC Rajkumar (No. 2895/T), and HC Phool Chand (No. 4870/T), was deployed at Vikram Batra Chowk towards Rohini for intensive checking and traffic regulation duties.

During the course of checking, the team intercepted a suspicious Scooty rider and asked him to produce the vehicle documents. Sensing imminent apprehension, the rider abruptly abandoned the Scooty and fled from the spot by jumping over the central verge/divider. Despite immediate pursuit by the staff, the suspect managed to escape taking advantage of dense and fast-moving traffic.

The abandoned Scooty bearing registration number DL-8SBW-3*** was promptly verified through auto match No. 011274926, which revealed the following:

Status: Stolen

Legal Action: e-FIR No. 018149/2026 already registered at PS Samaypur Badli.

The recovered vehicle was taken into police possession and deposited in the Model Town Circle PIT. The Investigating Officer (IO) of PS Samaypur Badli has been duly informed for further necessary legal proceedings and formal handover of the case property.
