The New Year eve in Delhi will be celebrated with great enthusiasm and fervour. The festivities will be held at Restaurants, Malls and other public places. A large number of people will visit place of entertainment using various type of conveyances which may cause road congestion on roads. Following are the main places where people in large numbers assemble for celebration: -

Delhi Traffic Police made elaborate traffic arrangements throughout the city for the smooth flow and regulation of traffic on the eve of New Year covering whole of Delhi where such celebrations may be organized. The following **restrictions shall be imposed from 8.00 PM onwards on 31.12.2023** in the vicinity of Delhi till the conclusion of New Year Celebrations. It will be applicable to all private and public transport vehicles.

1. No vehicle shall be allowed to proceed towards Connaught Place beyond (i) R/A Mandi House (ii) R/A Bengali Market (iii) North foot of Ranjit Singh Flyover (iv) Minto Road – Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Marg crossing (v) Chelmsford Road near Munje Chowk (New Delhi Rly. Station) (vi) R.K. Ashram Marg-Chitragupta Marg Crossing (vii) R/A Gole Market (viii) R/A G.P.O., New Delhi (viii) Patel Chowk (ix) Kasturba Gandhi Road - Ferozeshah Road Crossing (x) Jai Singh Road-Bangla Sahib Lane (xi) R/A Windsor place.

2. No vehicular traffic shall be allowed in inner, middle or outer circle of Connaught Place except for those that are carrying valid Passes.

Parking Arrangements (For Connaught Place)

Motorists can park their vehicles at the following places in the vicinity of Connaught Place:-

(i) Near Gol Dak Khana on

(a) Kali Bari Marg (b) Pt. Pant Marg (c) Bhai Veer Singh Marg

- (ii) Near Patel Chowk on Rakab Ganj Road behind AIR.
- (iii) Near Mandi House on Copernicus Marg upto Baroda House.
- (iv) Near Minto Road on D.D. Upadhaya Marg and Press Road area.
- (v) Near Panchkuian Road on R.K. Ashram Marg, Chitragupta Road &Basant Road towards PaharGanj.
- (vi) Near K.G. Marg-Ferozshah Road Crossing on Copernicus Lane as well as K.G.Marg towards C hexagon..
- (vii) Near R/A Bengali market on Babar Road and Tansen Marg
- (viii) Near Windsor Place (a) Rajender Prasad Road (b) Raisina Road
- (ix) Near Gole Market at Peshwa Road, Service Road along Bhai Veer Singh Marg and R K Ashram Road.
- (x) Near R/A Buta Singh on JantarMantar Road, Raisina Road.

Limited parking space will be available near Connaught Place on first come first serve basis. Improperly parked vehicles will be towed away and prosecuted.

• Access to New Delhi Railway Station (From South Delhi)

- i) Ram Manohar Lohiya Park Street- Mandir Marg- Rani Jhansi Road- R/A Jhandewalan- DeshBandhu Gupta Road.
- ii) R/A GPO- Kali Bari Marg- Mandir Marg- Rani Jhansi Road- R/A Jhandewalan- DeshBandhu Gupta Road.
- iii) R/A Windsor Place- Ferozeshah Road- Mandi House- 'W' Point- 'A' Point-DDU Marg- BhavBhuti Marg.
- iv) Entry from Connaught Place Chelmsford Road shall be prohibited.
- v) Motorists can take Second Entry Gate of Ajmeri Gate side. They can reach the station via Pahar Ganj – Shiela Cinema or through Ajmeri Gate – J.L.N. Marg side via B.S.Z. Marg – Delhi Gate – J.L.N. Marg.
- Old Delhi Railway Station is not affected.

Suggested routes for North Delhi to South Delhi movement-

Motorists are advised to use alternative routes available

- Ring Road from ISBT to Ashram or
- via Delhi Gate, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Mathura Road to reach Ashram and via vice-versa or
- via ISBT, Rani Jhansi Marg, Panchkuiyan Road, Mandir Marg, Park Street, Mother Teresa Crescent Road & beyond or
- ➢ via Rani Jhansi Marg, Panchkuiyan Road, Hanuman Murti, Ring Road.

Commuters are suggested to avoid below mentioned routes in West Delhi:-

- Najafgarh Road, (Dwarka Mor to Zakhira flyover) & Outer Ring Road (From Janak Puri to Peeragarh Chowk)
- For Club Road Punjabi Bagh all commercial traffic including DTC Buses coming from Raja Garden and going towards Baba Ram Dev Marg (Paschim Puri) will be restricted to take left turn on Club Road from 4 PM on 31-12-2023 upto 4 AM on 01-01-2024. Traffic will be diverted straight towards Round About Punjabi Bagh then turn left on Rohtak Road towards Paschim Puri.

Suggested route for East Delhi to West Delhi movement-

Ring Road, Bhairon Road, Mathura Road, Subramaniam Bharti Marg, Mother Teresa Crescent, R/A R.M.L, Park Street, Shankar Road.

<u>Commuters are suggested to avoid below mentioned routes in South Delhi.</u>

- > Avoid Press Enclave Road Saket to go towards Ring Road.
- Avoid Firoz Gandhi Marg and Veer Savarkar Marg to go Central Market Lajpat Nagar.
- Avoid Bhisham Pitamah Marg to go toward New Delhi from Andrews Ganj and from Lodhi Road to go towards Ring Road AIIMS.
- As there will be heavy traffic due to New year celebration at Ambience Mall Vasant Kunj, Avoid Nelson Mandela Road to go to Gurugram, use Olof Palme Marg, RTR.
- Traffic advisory nearby Hauz Khas Village, Avoid Ring Road between Moti Bagh to Safdarjung Hospital. Use RTR Aurobindo Marg and Brig. Hoshiyar Singh Marg to go to IGI Airport.
- > **Traffic advisory nearby Aerocity,** due to New year celebration at various places in Aerocity the traffic movement may be slow as there will be intensive checking at the entrance of Aerocity, commuters who are planning to go to Airport are advised to plan their travel keeping sufficient time in hand.
- > Traffic will remain heavy at Hansraj Gupta Marg due to New Year celebration at **GK-1 Market.**

Restrictions on vehicles on New Year at India Gate

Delhi Traffic Police has made elaborate traffic arrangements, at and around India Gate for regulation of traffic both pedestrian and vehicular. In case of heavy pedestrian movement, vehicles may not be allowed to go through C-Hexagon, India Gate area and diverted from the following place:

- 2. R/A MLNP
- 3. R/A SUNHERI MASJID
- 4. R/A MAR-JANPATH
- 5. KARTAVYAPATH- RAFI MARG
- 6. R/A WINDSOR PLACE
- 7. R/A RAJINDRA PRASAD ROAD-JANPATH
- 8. KG MARG-FEROZESHAH ROAD
- 9. R/A MANDI HOUSE
- 10.W-POINT
- 11. MATHURA ROAD-PURANA QILA ROAD
- 12. MATHURA ROAD-SHER SHAH ROAD
- 13.SBM-ZAKIR HUSSAIN MARG
- 14.SBM-PANDARA ROAD

Visitors are advised to use public transport as there is shortage of parking space at India Gate. In view of large gathering expected at Delhi Zoo resulting in congestion on Mathura Road, the General Public/Motorists are advised to avoid Bhairon Road/Mathura Road between Hazrat Nizamuddin and Pragati Maidan.

Special Checkings:-

- Strict action shall be taken against drunken driving (U/S 185 MVA), over speeding (U/S 112/183 MVA), stunt biking, reckless driving, zig-zag and dangerous driving (U/S 184 MVA) etc.
- > Detective cameras are installed to prosecute the violators.
- > Special drive have been initiated in all over Delhi.
- > Staff with Alcometer have been deployed at various junctions.
- > Strict actions will be taken against stunt bikers and over speeding vehicles.
