OFFICE OF THE DY. COMMISSIONER OF POLICE: TRAFFIC : DELHI:

No. 15359-459 /TE(D.III) dated Delhi, the 17.10.97

Whereas it is necessary to ensure the smooth flow of traffic and the safety of road users on Narwana Road.

And whereas the problem of safety of road users and residents on the stretch of Narwana Road due to the movement of Heavy Goods Vehicles and Medium Goods Vehicles has assumed serious proportions and is endangering the life of road users.

NOW, therefore, I, Qamar Ahmed, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Traffic, Delhi in exercise of powers conferred upon me under Regulation 30(1) of the Delhi Control of Vehicular and other Traffic on Roads & Streets Regulations, 1980 do hereby prohibit the plying of Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGVs) and Medium Goods Vehicles (MGVs) on the stretch of entire Narwana Road (East Delhi) for 24 hours.

This order shall be published for the information of the general public in the official gazette and by affixing a copy on the Notice Boards of the offices of all District Deputy Commissioners of Police and all Police Stations in Delhi/New Delhi.

The concerned civil agency and road maintaining authorities shall erect the corresponding sign boards indicating the restriction in the area for the information and convenience of all concerned.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
