**CIRCULAR**

**Sub:- Notification and action regarding slow moving vehicles.**

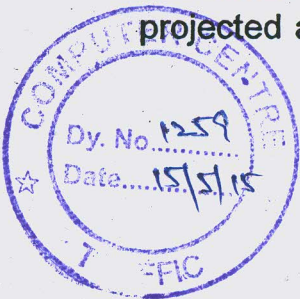
Recently an accident took place on 04.01.2015 between a bullock cart and a motor cycle which resulted in human injuries. A case FIR No. 12/15 u/s 279/337, IPC in this respect was registered at P.S. Ranjeet Nagar on 05.01.2015. The Hon'ble Court of Sh. Anoop Kumar Mendiratta in its order dated 06.05.2015 in 251/15 – Rajesh Vs. Untraced has passed the following observation/direction:-

*“Proper signages need to be put up near the commercial markets and roads prone to traffic jams wherein the bullock carts are generally used for transportation. The steps be specifically taken in the stretch of Old Delhi from Idgah to Burfkhana (Subzi Mandi) wherein the regulation of movement of slow moving vehicles is required to prevent massive traffic jams, congestion and obstruction to smooth flow of traffic in peak hours.”*

To regulate the movement of slow moving traffic on various roads in Delhi/New Delhi areas and to ensure the convenience and safety of lives of residents, children and other road users restrictions have been imposed by Delhi Traffic Police from time to time on plying of slow moving vehicles i.e. bullock carts, tongas, cycle rickshaws, hand carts etc. in the various parts of NCT of Delhi. Details of these restrictions are enclosed at **Annexure – ‘A’**. However, it has been observed that there is lack of adequate attention of field functionaries towards these restrictions and no action is being undertaken by them against unauthorized plying of slow moving vehicles.

All DCsP/T-Ranges, ACsP/T-Districts and TIs/Circle are hereby directed to brief their prosecuting officers accordingly and take immediate necessary action against violators under the provisions of DP Act, 1978 to implement the above directions in true letter and spirit.

The field officers may also be directed to educate/sensitize the drivers of animal driven vehicles do not carry excessive load and carry a lighted lamp projected at the end of the cart during dark hours and also paste reflectors and red

## **Regulation Regarding Plying of Animal Driven Vehicles on Delhi Roads.**

### **A) The Delhi Control Of Vehicular And Other Traffic On Roads And Streets Regulations – 1980. (Framed u/s 28 of Delhi Police Act, 1978)**

#### **Regulation No. 6:- CERTAIN VEHICLES TO HAVE LAMP DURING NIGHT**

Every vehicle, cart or carriage drawn by an animal or pulled or pushed by hand shall, while plying on a road or street during the period falling between half an hour after sunset and half an hour before sunrise, have two lamps one on each side showing bright light forward and red light clearly visible from behind, even if such a conveyance is not carrying any load whatsoever.

#### **Regulation No. 13:- ANIMAL-DRAWN VEHICLES TO BE IN CONTROL**

No person having the care of any vehicle drawn by an animal shall be at such a distance from such vehicles as not to have complete control over the animal drawing the same.

#### **Regulation No. 20:- RESTRICTION OF ANIMAL-DRIVEN OR HAND-PULLED VEHICLES**

No animal-driven or hand-pulled vehicles shall be allowed to ply on such road or street and during such hours as may be notified from time to time to by the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Traffic, Delhi.

### **B) Delhi Police Act, 1978**

#### **Section 59:- DUTY OF POLICE OFFICER TO ENFORCE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT. –**

1. It shall be the duty of every police officer to ensure compliance with the provisions of this Act or any rule, regulation or order made thereunder and for that purpose such police officer may,-

(a) warn persons who from ignorance fail to comply with any provisions of this Act or any rule, regulation or order made thereunder;

(b) require any person acting or about to act contrary to any provision of this Act or rule, regulation or order made thereunder, to desist from so doing;

(c) subject to the provisions of sub-sections (2) and (3), arrest any person contravening any provision of this Act or any rule, regulation or order made, thereunder, where such contravention is an offence punishable under this Act;



(d) seize any object used, or about to be used, in contravening, or in contravention of, the provisions of this Act or any rule, regulation or order made thereunder, where such contravention is an offence punishable under this Act.

2. A police officer shall not arrest any person under clause (c) of sub-section (1) without a warrant issued by a Metropolitan Magistrate, unless such person –

(a) has contravened any regulation made under clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 28;

(b) has contravened any order or notification made under section 29, sub-section (1) or sub-section (2) of section 30, section 32, section 47, section 48 or sub-section (1) of section 57;

(c) commits in the presence of such police officer an offence punishable under section 97, sub-section (1) of section 108, clause (a), (b) or (c) of section 110 or sub-section (2) of section 113 in respect of the contravention of any order made under section 33 or section 34;

(d) has committed, or is reasonably suspected to have committed, an offence punishable under section 100 in relation to any dwelling house, private premises or any other land or ground attached thereto;

Provided that the person in possession or having charge of that dwelling house, private premises or land or ground complains of the commission of such offence;

(e) has committed, or is reasonably suspected to have committed an offence punishable under section 101, section 102 or clause (c) of sub-section (2) of section 113;

(f) commits in his presence in any street or public place any non-cognizable offence punishable under this Act or any rule or regulation made thereunder if such person –

(i). after being warned by the police officer persists in committing such offence; or

(ii). Refuses to accompany the police officer to a police station on being required so to do.

3. The Commissioner of Police or any other police officer especially empowered in this behalf by the Commissioner of Police may arrest without a warrant issued by a Metropolitan Magistrate any person who has committed an offence punishable under section 92.

**Section 66:- POLICE TO TAKE CHARGE OF UNCLAIMED PROPERTY. –**

1. It shall be the duty of every police officer to take temporary charge –
  - (a) of all unclaimed property found by, or made over to, him; and
  - (b) of all property found lying in any public street, if the owner or person in charge of such property, on being directed to remove the same, refuses or fails to do so.
2. The police officer taking charge of the property under sub-section (1) shall furnish an inventory thereof to the Commissioner of Police.

**Section 110:- PENALTY FOR CONTRAVENING REGULATIONS ETC., UNDER SECTION 28. –** Save as provided in section 112, whoever contravenes, or abets the contravention of, any regulation made under section 28 or any of the conditions of licence issued under such regulation shall, on conviction, be punished –

- (a) If the regulation was made under clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 28 providing for the prohibition of the sale, or exposure for sale, of any goods on any street or portion thereof so as to cause obstruction to traffic or in convenience to the public –
  - (i). for the first offence, with imprisonment for a term which may extend to one month, or with fine which may extend to two hundred rupees, or with both, and
  - (ii). for any subsequent offence, with imprisonment for a term which may extend to six months and with fine which may extend to five hundred rupees;
- (b) If the regulation was made under clauses (d), (h), (i), or (j), sub-clause (i), of (ii) of clause (s) or clause (v) of sub-section (1) of section 28, with imprisonment for a term which may extend to eight days, or with fine which may extend to fifty rupees or with both;
- (c) If the regulation was made under clause (o) or (p) of sub-section (1) of section 28, with fine which may extend to two hundred rupees; and
- (d) If the regulation was made under any clause of sub-section (1) of section 28 and for the contravention of which no penalty is provided under clause (a), (b) or (c) of this section, with fine which may extend to fifty rupees.
