ORDER

Subject:- Implementation of the directions of the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety.

This is in-continuation to Jt.CP/Traffic office circular issued vide No. 822-96/P.Sec/Jt.CP/T, dated 08.03.2017 and this office circular issued vide Nos. 7742-7830/TE (D-I)/Traffic, dated 17.09.2018, 7908-7994/TE (D-I)/Traffic dated 20.09.2018 and 3576-3664/TE (D-I)/Traffic, dated 08.04.2019. Copies of the above mentioned circulars on the subject cited above are re-circulated to ensure necessary compliance. The enforcement officers of Delhi Traffic Police seize driving license of an offender for traffic violations as specified by the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety viz. over speeding, red light jumping, using mobile phone while driving, driving under the influence of alcohol and drugs and carrying passengers on goods vehicles. The driving license so seized by the enforcement officers of Delhi Traffic Police are then forwarded to the concerned Transport Deptt./Authority of GNCT of Delhi/State (s) for initiating action for suspension of the driving license by them for a minimum period of 3 months or more.

It has been observed that still a number of complaints are being received from motorists regarding gone missing/lost/non-availability of driving licenses seized by the enforcement officers of Delhi Traffic Police during prosecution of traffic violations by them. It has also been reported and observed that the seized driving licenses are also being kept in the concerned traffic circles for a long time without any valid reasons. It is mandatory for all the enforcement officers of Delhi Traffic Police to send the seized driving licenses for the specified traffic offences as per the directions of the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety through their traffic circles to the concerned nodal officers of Transport Department/Authority of GNCT of Delhi/State (s) **within 7 days positively** to the Centralized Driving License Suspension Cell at Room No. 120, 1st Floor, Transport Department, GNCT of Delhi, 5/9 Under Hill Road, Delhi – 110054, as per the following schedule:-

Sl. No.	Day	Districts
1.	Monday	South, South-West and South-East Distts.
2.	Tuesday	West, North and North-West Distts.
3.	Wednesday	Central and Outer Distts.
4.	Thursday	East & North- East Distts.
5.	Friday	Dwarka and New Delhi Distts.

The seized driving licenses should be forwarded to the concerned nodal officers of Transport Department, GNCT of Delhi with a proper Road Certificate while for nodal officers of other State (s) Transport Authorities, the same should be forwarded through registered post. Proper records in this respect should be maintained in a separate register in each traffic circle. **No seized driving license shall be kept pending in the concerned traffic circle for more than 7 days.** TI of the concerned Traffic Distt. shall be the nodal officer to monitor the same on day to day basis and ensure that the seized driving licenses are sent to the concerned Transport Deptt./Authority of GNCT of Delhi/State (s) and an intimation in this respect should also be conveyed to the driving license holder with proper receipt, etc., as per the procedure already defined. After the driving license is forwarded to the concerned nodal officer of the Transport Department, GNCT of Delhi or State (s) Transport Authority, an intimation should also be sent to the driving license holder (violator) through post about his/her driving license with details of office dispatch number, date, etc., for his/her future reference for contacting with the concerned nodal officer to get the seized driving license back after suspension, a copy of the format at **Annexure-'A'** specifying the intimation in this respect is enclosed for ready reference which should be followed in each case.

It is further re-treated that:-

- i. With regard to **Note in red ink** at the bottom of acknowledgement receipt issued by Delhi Traffic Police, the following should be written instead of present Note:-

Note: "This Acknowledgment shall entitle the offender to drive for a period of 45 days (earlier it was 90 days) or till his/her driving license suspended by the licensing authority whichever is earlier. If driving License not received within 137 days from the date of challan, then Driving License Holder may contact to room No. 120A, DL Suspension Cell, Transport Department, 5/9 Under Hill Road, Delhi – 110054" (with ID proof).

- ii. If the acknowledgment receipts are already printed, a stamp to be affixed at the back side of each challan receipt of the above note, and already printed note be crossed/cancelled till the present printed stock exhausted.
- iii. The Driving License number should be uploaded on the portal in the same manner as printed on driving licenses.
- iv. Mobile number of Driving License holder's be written on acknowledgement receipt by challaning officer of Delhi Traffic Police and be uploaded on portal for the convenience of public and transport department.

All DCsP/T-Ranges and ACsP/T-Districts are requested to brief and sensitize all the enforcement officials posted under their operational control to ensure meticulous compliance of the above directions in true letter and spirit.

Non-compliance of above directions shall be viewed seriously.

CIRCULAR

Subject:- Implementation of directions of Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety.

This is in continuation of various circulars issued from time to time by Traffic (HQ) on the subject. The enforcement officers of Delhi Traffic Police seize driving license of an offender for traffic violations as specified by the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety viz. using mobile phone while driving, driving under the influence of drink and drugs, carrying persons in goods vehicles, over speeding and red light jumping. The driving licenses so seized by the enforcement officers of Delhi Traffic Police are then forwarded to the concerned Transport Department/Authority of GNCT of Delhi/State (s) for initiating action for suspension of the driving license by them for a minimum period of 3 months or more.


It has been observed that a large number of complaints are being received from motorists regarding gone missing/lost /non availability of driving licenses seized by the enforcement officers of Delhi Traffic Police during prosecution of traffic violations by them. It has also been reported and observed that the seized driving licenses are also being kept in the concerned traffic circles for a long time without any valid reasons.

Henceforth, it shall be mandatory for all the enforcement officers of Delhi Traffic Police to send the seized driving licenses for the specified traffic offences as per the directions of the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety through their traffic circles to the concerned nodal officers of Transport Department/Authority of GNCT of Delhi/State (s) **within 7 days positively**. The seized driving licenses should be forwarded to the concerned nodal officers of Transport Department, GNCT of Delhi with proper Road Certificate while for nodal officers of other State (s) Transport Authorities, the same should be forwarded through registered post. Proper records in this respect should be maintained in separate registers in each traffic circle. **No seized driving license shall be kept pending in the concerned traffic circle for more than 7 days.** TI of the concerned Traffic Distt. shall be the nodal officer to monitor the same on day to day basis and ensure that the seized driving licenses are sent to the concern Transport

Department/Authority of GNCT of Delhi/State (s) and an intimation in this respect should also be conveyed to the driving license holder with proper receipt etc. as per the procedure already defined. After the driving license is forwarded to the concerned nodal officer of the Transport Department, GNCT of Delhi or State (s) Transport Authority, an intimation should also be sent to the driving license holder (violator) through post about his/her driving license with details of office dispatch number, date etc. for his/her future reference for liaisoning with the concerned nodal officer to get the seized driving license back after suspension. A copy of the format at Annexure 'A' specifying the intimation in this respect is enclosed for ready reference which should be followed in each case. All ACsP/Traffic Distts. and TIs/Circle are directed to brief the staff working under their operational control for following these directions with immediate effect. Weekly Goshwara shall be sent to ACsP/T-Distt. & DCsP/T-Ranges. A register shall be maintained in the circle for record and it shall be counter signed by TI/Circle each day.

All DCsP/T-Ranges shall also ensure meticulous compliance of this order in true letter and spirit.

Non compliance of above directions shall be viewed seriously.

Dy. Commissioner (Operations), Transport Department, GNCT of Delhi has informed that for effective implementation of Suspension of Driving Licenses of the traffic violators for offences viz. over speeding, red light jumping, using mobile phone while driving and carrying passengers on goods vehicles by Delhi Traffic Police in compliance of the directions of the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety and systematic return of such licenses to the license holders, Centralised Driving License Suspension Cell has been established at Room No. 120, 1st Floor, Transport Department, GNCT of Delhi, 5/9 Under Hill Road, Delhi – 110054.

All ACsP/T-Districts and TIs/Circles are hereby directed to send the driving licenses of the traffic violators for traffic offences viz. over speeding, red light jumping, using mobile phone while driving and carrying passengers on goods vehicles in compliance of the directions of the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety to Centralised Driving License Suspension Cell at the above address only. In order to have systematic receipt of challaned driving license, it is directed to send seized driving licenses in the following schedule:-

Sl. No.	Day	Districts
1.	Monday	South, South-West & South-East Distts.
2.	Tuesday	West, North & North-West Distts.
3.	Wednesday	Centre & North Distts.
4.	Thursday	East & North- East Distts.
5.	Friday	Dwarka & New Delhi Distts.

All ACsP/T-Districts and TIs/Circles are also hereby directed to follow the procedure below:-

- After challaning, traffic police will upload the details of offenders in the online software first alongwith mobile number of the offender. The Challaning Officer should invariably obtain the mobile number while challaning for sending SMS to the registered mobile number of the traffic violator at every stage, at the time of challaning, issuance of show-cause notice, issuance of suspension orders and at the time of return of Driving Licenses.

- b. Instead of sending seized driving licenses to different Zonal MLOs, all the seized driving licenses are to be sent to Driving License Suspension Cell at Centralised Driving Licenses Suspension Cell in Room No. 120, 1st Floor, Transport Department, GNCT of Delhi, 5/9 Under Hill Road, Delhi – 110054.
- c. Transport Deptt., GNCT of Delhi as per the above schedule.
- d. The grace period from the date of challan be restricted to 30 days only.

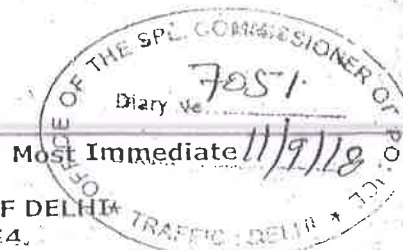

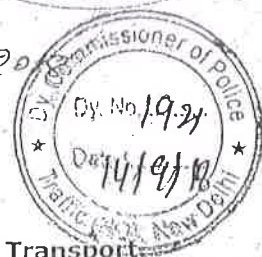

b. Instead of sending driving licensees to different zones, all the driving licenses are to be sent to Driving License Suspension Cell at HQ, Transport Department as per the above schedule.

c. The grace period from the date of challan be restricted to 30 days only.

4. A SMS will be sent to the registered mobile number of the traffic violator at every stage, at the time of challaning, issuance of show-cause notice, issuance of suspension orders and at the time of return of Driving Licenses.

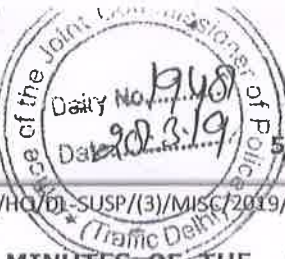

(B) Driving License holders can collect their Driving license which are returned by postal department from D/L Suspension cell, room no-120A with Identity proof between 2:00 Pm to 5:00 Pm. The details of such driving licenses will be uploaded on the website of Transport Department Delhi.

(C) The Driving licenses seized by Delhi Traffic Police in violation of honorable supreme court committee (Road Safety) will be sent back to the holder through postal department (by speed post). 

If Driving License Not Received within 137 days from the date of challan, then Driving License Holder may contact to room no. 120 A, DL Suspension cell, Transport Department, 5/9 Under Hill Road, Delhi-110054" (with ID proof)

(ii) If the challan receipts are already printed, a stamp to be affixed back side of each challan receipt of above note and already printed note be crossed/cancelled till the present printed stock exhausted.

(iii) The Driving License number should be uploaded on the portal in the same manner as printed on driving licenses.

(iv) Mobile number of Driving License holder's be written on challan receipt by challaning officer of Delhi Traffic Police and be uploaded on portal for public convenience and transport department use.
